33 Day Consecration to Jesus Through the Immaculate Heart of Mary

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Day Eleven (11) The World's Darkness

Clear images

We easily understand darkness and light because we experience both everyday. Darkness represents the world rejecting Jesus. Light is an image of the disciple walking with him. On many occasions the gospels use these images.

Judas' Night

Having decided to betray Jesus, Judas left the Last Supper. The gospel says, "It was night," both in Jerusalem and Judas' heart. He had rejected Jesus because Judas loved darkness rather than the light. It is said that "a man who walks in darkness does not know where he's going". That describes Judas who is walking the fatal path of a betrayer.

Mary Magdalene (From Darkness to Light)

Mary Magdalene was in the deepest darkness entrapped by 7 demons, until Jesus cast them out, then brought her into the greatest light. On Easter Sunday while it was still dark Mary knew to go to the tomb. She met Jesus there and when he said, "Mary," she realized that He was risen. The woman of darkness was the first to see the risen Jesus, the light of the world. Most people think of themselves as "filled with light". However, nothing could be further from the truth. The saints always realized how much darkness surrounded them. They never trusted their own light. Without Mary our mother leading us to Jesus, we have only the world's darkness to guide us. It is always "still dark" until true devotion leads us to Jesus.

Will you accept the light?

Saint Augustine listened every Sunday to the preaching of Saint Ambrose but he admits, "I always said tomorrow and tomorrow." One day, his moment of light came. "I was in the garden and I heard a child's voice say, "Take and read. Take and read. I picked up the Bible and read, 'The night is far spent. The day is at hand. Let us throw off the works of darkness and put on the armor of light." Augustine wept and accepted the light. This 33 days journey invites you to do the same - throw off darkness and be clothed in Mary's light.

The Virtues

Vices tend to show the darkness of our hearts. There is no self control (temperance), no prudence, no true piety, or real charity. There is only a deep emptiness that does not seem to end. On this day, dear child, you are asked to shed yourself of the dark vices that run deep within you. It will not be easy. But, you have a great aid, the Lady of Light, our heavenly Mother. As part of this 33 day journey, begin to rid yourself of this darkness, and let the warmth of true light from your Mother come in. Listen to Her carefully tell you, "do as my Son says. Let go of yourself, and follow Him."
