I Have Sinned

The prodigal son was greedy give me my inheritance. He was also self-reliant, he set off for distant country. He soon became poor and needy. This experience caused him to reflect and he came to his senses. And it also led him to the perfect conclusion - "I shall get up and go back to my father". He also knew what to say, "father I have sinned against heaven and against you." As children we were taught to begin our confession by saying bless me father for I have sinned. We all sin but we don't admit it. We turn the spotlight on everybody else's faults and keep the light away from our own hearts.

While Jesus was teaching in the temple a crowd brought a woman caught in adultery. She was alone in the spotlight. Jesus turned that light around by saying whoever is without sin cast the first stone. Of course, no one qualified and her accusers walked away.

The Spotlight

Jesus is the spotlight truth. Through true and real devotion, we allow Him to shine in our hearts, knowing that His light will reveal our sins. Our sins are real. We committed them and we do not need to hide them. They are infections causing emotional and spiritual fevers. So, we have to remove them for our spiritual health.

Isaiah's Experience

When God called Isaiah to be his prophet, he lifted him up to heaven. Isaiah realized where he was and whom he was seeing. He cried out, "Woe is me, I am a man of unclean lips. yet my eyes have seen the King, the Lord of hosts." God provided the solution. The Angel purified his lips with fire from the altar.

God has provided this fire for you also. "Go, show yourselves to the priest," Jesus said to the leper. During these 33 days make a good confession. You might want to tell the priest that you are preparing for your Marian Consecration, and would like to make a sincere confession. Mary will guide his words, while the Holy Spirit moves you to speak out your failures.

St. Charles de Foucauld

Charles led a wild life in the French Foreign Legion. When he returned to France he lived with a devout cousin. One day he accompanied her to church, and there he saw a priest hearing confessions. He really wanted to discuss something else, but the priest got him to confess. Afterwards he said "if God forgave me all my sins, I should love him with my whole heart". From that point forward, he said yes.

The Virtues

It's easy to say, "yeah I'm a sinner". But do you really admit it? Do you feel any shame in that? If you really and honestly do, then why do you keep sinning? Making this 33 day journey is about realizing where our faults and failures are. But we can't just stop there by recognizing them. We must change! We must convert our lives into something better, not the same usual excuses. Our Mother is pointing out all these faults, and she is saying "dear child, why do you resist? Please let go of your pride." Let us listen to Her, and walk away from our sins.

St. Louis de Montfort writes:

- 1. The cross is a fire that purifies the iron of the soul's rust.
