Day Nine (9)

The World's Despair

Life on earth is very difficult. Even modern man, with all his conveniences, finds so much lacking. Suffering can come at any time and in many forms. The simplicities of childhood are quickly replaced with teenage and young adult anxieties. The requirements of "growing up" and becoming older get more complicated. Victories are followed by defeats. Dreams are often destroyed, sometimes in a single moment. God never intended the world to be this difficult, but mankind changes earth through sin.

Even a young person, or any person for that matter, can question, "What is the purpose of my life?". The world's answers offer little satisfaction and cannot save the person from hopelessness.

Always Hope with God

After God rejected Cain's sacrifice, He still offered him hope, "Why are you so despairing?. If you do well, you can hold up your head" (Gen 4:7). Later, after murdering Abel, Cain feared others would kill him. God, however, saved him by a mark. "The Lord put a mark on Cain lest anyone should kill him (Gen 4:15). God offers hope to everyone, even those with gigantic problems.

The Secret of Hope

Despair results when a person cannot overcome his/her problems. Hope results when a person realizes God is helping him/her with their problems. We can always hope because God will change our circumstances and us.

When the alcoholic hopes in a higher power, his despair is destroyed. The world does not admit any power higher than itself and is doomed to despair. However, "We have put our hope in Him that He will rescue us again." (2 Cor 1:10).

Mary's Role

On the cross Jesus gave to the disciple His own mother. Jesus gave up everything, with arms wide open. And His last precious gift was that of His mother, to us. Trust that She will lead you from searching to finding, from despair to hope. She has helped millions, and you are her next success story.

The Virtues
