Day Twenty Nine (29)

Jesus Hates Sin

The modern world has painted a false idea of Jesus Christ. By selectively choosing some of His words, they fashion a Christ who tolerates everything, as if He just stands at heaven's gate waving everyone in, good or bad, saint or sinner.

The Gospel Picture

In Mark's gospel, Jesus' first words were "Repent and believe in the gospel." Jesus wants His friends to repent. After Jesus saved the woman from being stoned to death due to her sinful life, He said "I do not condemn you. From now on, sin no more". (Jn 8:11)

Many times, Jesus grew angry when He saw sin happening. In the synagogue, "He looked at them with anger, because of their hardness of heart" (Mk 3:5). Later, in the temple, Jesus overturned their money tables saying, "You have made my Father's house a den of thieves" (Mk 12:17)

The world tolerates everything and claims there is no sin. The gospel states that Jesus "will prove the world wrong about sin" (Jn 16:8). Is Jesus angry about our sins? Certainly He is, and He wants to take them away, if we let Him. That is His life's purpose. He is the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world" (Jn 1:29).

Jesus gathered sinners. They flocked to Him and joined His company. He welcomed them. They felt no shame. The past was the past and they had gladly left their sins behind them. They all had stories to tell, the "before", and the "after". They spoke of what they were like before they met Jesus. Now, they were "new creations." The past darkness had changed to light.

Read the gospel stories. See for yourself. Jesus welcomed sinners. They felt very much at home in His presence. They also knew to change their lives because everybody else was trying to be like Jesus.

The Virtues

Make no mistake about it, Jesus does not like, or approve of sinful ways. He loves you for sure, but as we said before He loves you too much to let you destroy yourself, your life, and your soul. He came for one purpose, to take all the sin of the world, and to offer Himself up as a sacrifice for us. If you still continue in your sinful ways, pause and think. Am I really following my Lord? Am I really making Him happy? Am I really hurting my loving Mother, who has walked with me, and guided me these past several days? You know the answer. You know what you must do, to really change. But you're having trouble being consistent with repenting and avoiding sin. This is why you are on this 33 day journey. To know who you are, what has been done for you, and what you must do. Please, no more wasting time. Repent now, and live a true life of virtue.
